Ministry of Tribal Affairs (MoTA), through its Fellowship Scholarship Scheme is providing scholarship to 4794 research scholars of ST Category for doing MPhil and PhD from select Universities across the country. In order to get connect with these scholars, harness their strength by understanding their areas of interest, inculcate national ethos and empowering them to develop as entrepreneurs, and make them aware about various other schemes of Govt of India, MoTA has initiated concept of Tribal Talent Pool and has designed a framework with Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA). First interaction with such scholars was organized in Delhi through a 3-day workshop from 3rd to 5th December, where 57 students from 7 Universities in Delhi participated. The workshop had interactive session with Officers of Ministry, Corporate, NGO; and a field visit to Rewadi (digital Village) village in Haryana. Their communication and presentation skills were analysed through Group Discussion and presentations. Keeping in view the enthusiastic response of scholars, MoTA plans to launch this initiative across India by organizing similar workshops all over India in co-operation with some Universities. The selected scholars will be nominated as brand ambassadors of MoTA in their respective districts in their area of expertise and will be coopted in various schemes and initiatives of MoTA in the coming years.

- 2. Further, MoTA is collaborating with the Facebook India on their project GOAL (Going Online as Leaders) project, primarily aimed at digital literacy and also envisages to nurture, develop and promote the existing and budding Tribal talents in various fields with Mentor-Mentee concept across the country. Under this initiative Facebook will also mentor 250 scholars from the tribal talent pool.
- 3. PMO is being requested for seeking convenience of **Hon'ble Prime Minister to launch this initiative and address tribal scholars**. For this purpose, MoTA is compiling information from all 4794 Research Scholars who are enrolled in PhD since 2011and has prepared webform for filling necessary details so that they can be contacted and invited for this program. The list of universities where such students are pursuing courses is also placed at https://tribal.nic.in/NFS1920. It is requested that the concerned department of University may be asked to coordinate with students to fill the information by 10th January 2020. 


