

Central University of Orissa farewells outgoing Vice-Chancellor Prof. Mohammad Miyan



The Central University of Orissa bid farewell to the former Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Mohammad Miyan, in a farewell functions held on July 4th at Ladiguda Campus of the University. The tenure of Prof. Mohammad Miyan, the Second vice-chancellor of Central University of Orissa and a role model in higher education ended on last month.
