

# CUO organizes Special Lecture in Social Sciences 'Framing Social Economy: An Alternative Approach to Development'

A special lecture in social sciences on 'Framing Social Economy: An Alternative Approach to Development' was organized by the Central University of Orissa, at its permanent campus Sunabeda. Prof. Sachidananda Mohanty, Vice-Chancellor of CUO inaugurated the programme as the Chief Guest and delivered the inaugural address. Prof. Anup Kumar Dash, Eminent Sociologist, Board of Directors, NABARD & Consultant to ILO, Geneva, delivered the special lecture.

Prof. Mohanty talked about the different journey of development in his inaugural address. He said "During the age of enlightenment there are four principles, there is a change on the four principles like Individualism, rationalism, universalism and progress". He also said "Education should not be a business, education should be for all. Education should not be for the highest bidder only". Reminding the value of time and opportunity to the students he advised them to utilize the opportunity that they get and they must carry out their responsibility



as the tax payers of the country provide them this opportunity.

Prof. Anup Dash gave importance on moral values for harmony in this materialistic world. While he pointing out the social disintegration in view of the society he said "Large part of the society is on the other side of the development. It is time that man must bring capital under the control of the society. We need to reconstruct ourselves with the theory of moral sentiments". In the context of the good society he said "A caring and sharing society is a good society". He reminds the young students that they have a responsibility to set a frame for social and natural set-up.
