- Construction of boundary wall of the Boys' Hostel and Girls' Hostel at the permanent campus.
- Construction of Academic Block (pre-fabricated) is on the verge of completion at the permanent campus.
- Work on building of internal road is on progress.
- Internal water supply has been made.
- Total of 15,000 saplings (ornamental and fruits plant) have been planted in the permanent campus.
- The boundary walls of Landiguda campus have been spruced up with tribal art.
- The University has adopted five villages in its periphery. The villages include Rajpalma, Chikappar, Chakarliput, Baldah and Nuagada.
- A village council has been constituted for the development of the villages.
- Internet connectivity will soon be a reality in the new campus.

I have great pleasure in complimenting the efforts of my colleagues, staff and students. As always, an organisation benefits from the valuable advice of its mentor groups. We, at the Central University of Orissa are grateful to the Executive Council, the Academic Council, the Finance Committee, the Court and other bodies of our University for all-round support.

We shall be holding regular meetings of such bodies and seek valuable inputs from all quarters including the alumni.

Let us hope that with the support from the State, the Centre and the national and international agencies, the Central University of Orissa will emerge as one of the leading centres of learning in the country in the decade or so.

JOINING, MEETINGS AND TALKS

07.08.2015

Professor Sachidananda Mohanty assumed charge as full time Vice-Chancellor of Central University of Orissa, Koraput on the 7th of August, 2015. Seventy percent cut in the funds made earlier have been restored. He also met Secretary and Joint Secretary of MHRD and UGC.

Professor Sachidananda Mohanty called upon the Governor of Odisha and the Chief Minister of Odisha at Bhubaneswar. He also met the Chief Secretary; the Chief Administrator of KBK; the Principal Secretary, Revenue and Disaster Management; the EIC cum Secretary; and the Principal Secretary, Energy. The issues discussed included water, electricity, road connectivity, land and cess.

PROGRESS

Long-awaited health centres have been set up at the temporary Landiguda campus and the permanent Sunabeda campus of CUO. It was inaugurated on 15th August, 2015. A physician has been appointed to cater to health care needs of students and staff. There is provision for free essential medicines.

Electricity supply to CUO permanent campus was made. The approach road from the N.H. to new campus was made fully functional. The permanent campus got water supply.

Work is on full swing for construction of boundary wall of the boys' hostel and girls' hostel at the permanent campus.

A new academic block is on the verge of completion at the permanent campus on the pre-fabricated academic block.

Work on building of internal road is on progress. Nearby area has been readied for this. Internal water supply has been made.

As part of green campus drive, a total of 15,000 saplings have been planted in the permanent campus.

Internet connectivity to new campus will be given soon.

Aesthetics has been inculcated. The boundary walls of Landiguda campus have been spruced up with tribal art. The same is also being replicated in the permanent campus.

Central University of Orissa was established by an Act of Parliament under the Central Universities Act, 2009 during the XI Plan Period at Koraput, Odisha.

Vision of the University:

- Collaborations/ Forging academic alliance/partnership with flagship research institutes, Universities
 in India and abroad and also with industries.
- Cross Border education as envisaged in the UNESCO document has taken on a new shape and new meaning in today's context;
- Induction of eminent Visiting Faculty by invitation;
- Setting up an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).

Mission of the University:

- To provide quality education for all, so that we may fortify the backbone of the nation.
- To disseminate 'inclusive education' to reach the unreached.
- To advocate a wholesome symbiosis of the indigenous and the global scene.
- To uphold a strongly grounded holistic worldview of the higher education.
- To create a niche of its own.

Accordingly the University has already formulated:

- A Policy Framework for University-Industry Linkages;
- A Policy Framework for International Linkages with Universities abroad;
- Policy Framework for the inculcation of the 'culture of quality' at all levels of governance, teaching and learning.

The objectives of Central University of Orissa:

- To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit;
- To make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, science and technology in its educational programmes;
- To make appropriate measures for promoting innovations in the teaching-learning process and interdisciplinary studies and research;
- To educate and train man-power for the development of the country;
- To establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology;
- To pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.



Addresses by His Excellency, Hon'ble President of India

The President of India Shri Pranab Mukherjee, who is the Visitor of all Central University of Orissa, addressed the students, faculty and staff of all the higher educational and research institutions of India twice during the year.

His first address was on 5th August, 2014 on the topic "Democracy and Governance".

The second address was on 19th January, 2015 on the topic "Parliament and Policy Making"

Both the addresses were conducted through videoconferencing organised by National Knowledge Network (NKN), Govt. of India. All the staff of the University attended the Conference at Video Conference Studio, Central University of Orissa.

Academic Profile

Classes for the Academic Year 2014-15 in seven P.G. Programmes, one Integrated P.G. Programme (5yrs.) and one B.Ed. Programme are going on from July - 2014. Total 668 students have taken admissions for the Academic Year 2014-15 in these programmes.

The Evaluation Process of the University is based on the Semester pattern with Choice-Based Credit System.

The Academic Calendar is strictly followed by the Departments and all the teaching learning activities were carried out as per the scheduled programmes. The Statutory Bodies of the University have duly approved M.Phil/Ph.D. Programmes in the subjects of Anthropology, Sociology, Odia and J&MC from the Academic Year 2013-14 and in Biodiversity and Conservation of Natural Resources from 2014-15. Total 33 scholars have taken admission for the Academic Year 2014-15.

Infrastructural Progress

In line with the vision of this University, we have confronted myriad hurdles and challenges in developing our Main Campus at Sunabeda, Koraput. In our efforts to improve the level of infrastructure and other ancillary facilities to meet the requirements of structural development at the Campus, the University has been able to create the required infrastructure to make the Campus functional from this Academic Year 2014-15.

Human Resources

The University at present is equipped with well-experienced Faculty Members and Non-Teaching staff. We have a number of Guest Lecturers in some subjects. The University has also created a pool of Eminent Visiting Faculty for providing additional exposure to its students.

Central Library of the University

Central Library has grown exponentially over the last years. Although, the Central Library of CUO is only 5 years old, it has achieved its objectives by providing certain value-added services to its teaching and students communities. So far it has 18475 books in its collection. Central Library is subscribing 82 print Journals/Magazines and more than 9000 E-Journals through UGC-Infonet Digital Library Consortium

Central Library is proud to provide access to JSTOR, Oxford University Press, Taylor & Francis, Springer, Project Muse, Wiley-Blackwell Publishing, Cambridge University Press, JCCC, MathSciNet, ISID database, Emerald, Science Direct & other E-Journals within a short period of time.

Transport Facility for students and staff

SCHOOL OF SOCIAL SCIENCES

Department of Anthropological Studies (DAS)

Department of Anthropological Studies is functioning in this University since 2009. Four batches of students have already completed their Masters degree. The fifth and sixth batch are going on. The Prestigious Rajiv Gandhi Chair for Tribal Studies has been sanctioned by the Ministry of Human Resources Development, Government of India, New Delhi.

In a moderate way the CTWCD has initiated to preserve various cultural products, tools and equipments, ornaments, arts, paintings, posters, photographs, costumes and monuments, tribals food items, beverages, grains, various types of herbal roots, shoots and fruits being consumed by the tribes of the Koraput region.

The collection of tribal literature for equipping the library is in progress.

Professor position for Rajiv Gandhi Chair for Tribal Studies has been advertised.

Research and Documentation on following tribal issues

- Tribal livelihood
- Constitutional provisions for tribals
- Forest rights
- Land alienation
- Indenture labour
- Tribal indebtedness
- Tribal culture and ritual practices



- Tribal traditional institutions
- Traditional knowledge on health practices, agricultural practices, and other spheres of social life
- Preparation of data base of tribal population (ethnographic accounts of tribes)
- Monitoring and evaluation of government schemes targeted to empower the tribals
- Tribal handicrafts products

Skill Development Programmes

Looking into the socio-economic conditions of the people of the region, Central University of Orissa would like to empower tribes and needy people by providing training to unemployed and school dropout youths on a set of identified locally marketable vocations/trades in collaboration with civil society groups and government organizations.

CENTRE FOR INDIGENOUS STUDIES

By the active initiative of the Centre, the University is going to establish one specialized centre in the name of "Centre for Indigenous Studies", for which the University has already collaborated with Indigenous University of Wananga, New Zealand under India-New Zealand collaborative initiative. For the primary exchange programme, distinguished faculty from New Zealand and some other exports came to our University and one workshop was organised in our University.



CENTRAL LIBRARY

The importance of information needs of students, scholars and faculty to support their teaching, learning and research activities in an academic institution can hardly be over emphasized. Accordingly right from its inception, the University has developed a large collection of books, journals and periodicals in its Central Library. It has been set up as an integral part of the University system to cope with its multi-dimensional activities. It provides access to more than 18,475, books housed in its two campuses (one at Landiguda & the other one at Sunabeda).

Membership Strength

The University Library has been operating from its two campuses catering to more than 900 members comprising of students, faculty, research scholars and non-teaching staff. Besides these in-house members, the library also caters to the needs of scholars and visitors from other academic and research institutions.

Working Hours

To provide access to the multifarious needs and requirements of its users, the University Library remains open on all working days of the University from 09:30 hrs to 18:00 hrs.

Students and faculty of the University have been provided with user education and Orientation Programme.


Future Plans







NME-ICT Project: Central University of Orissa has entered into an ambitious plan executing agreement with the BSNL to implement the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NME-ICT) project, which is one of the prestigious projects by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) in collaboration with various IITs and PSU Major BSNL, India. This Project will enable the University to attain 1 GB connectivity. The main objective of the project is to cater to the learning needs of students, research scholars and faculties. In order to bolster knowledge resources, obtain and maintain the competitive edge in the world, academic institutions require such a system of identification and nurturing of talent through lifelong learning.



ENGINEERING/MAINTENANCE CELL

Land Matter

The Central University has been provided 430.37 acre of land on free of cost by the Government of Odisha near village Chikapar and Chakarliput of Semiliguda Tahsil for establishment of Central University of Orissa.

Power Supply to Sunabeda Campus

The electricity distribution company under the administrative control of Govt. of Odisha has laid a 5.5 km 11 KV line from Sunabeda GRID point to cubicle point inside the University campus through State funding. A power Transformer for dedicated electricity supply to CUO is under construction by SOUTHCO at an estimated cost of Rs.48,69,288/-The University has paid Rs. 18, 74,640/- towards security deposit to the General Manager, SOUTHCO, Jeypore for providing power supply to Sunabeda Campus.

The internal power supply work at an estimated cost of Rs.1.42 crore has been under way through CPWD. Soon after completion of the project, power can be restored to the campus.

Construction of Approach Road to the Central University of Orissa

The University is using the NAD road on request. However, the approach road up to the campus boundary has been taken up by R&B Division, Koraput (State Govt. of Odisha). The internal road network within the University boundary is being under taken as per Master Plan. The main road will be of 12 mtr with street lighting arrangement with ending of the road.

Water Supply to CUO Sunabeda Campus

As per the assessment, 3.00 lakhs litres per day drinking water is required for full functioning of Sunabeda Campus. A 5.0 km pipe line has been laid and two reservoirs have been constructed with the State Govt. funds. The internal water supply work is being under taken by University through State PHD with University funds.

One GB Connection to CUO Campus at Sunabeda

NMEICT is an approved and supported project of MHRD. The estimate cost of the project is Rs.2.00 crore of which the University's share is 25%. The BSNL has provided I GB connectivity up to campus point at Sunabeda. The connectivity is activated from Bhubaneswar ending with the Sunabeda Campus of Koraput. So far Router, UPS, Batteries have been procured.

The University has paid its share of 25% besides additional cost and service tax, etc. Through this project, the University can avail internet facilities up to 400 Nodes.

Notes on BSNL-1GB

For making provision of 1GB Broadband link under NME-ICT programme, the University has given its consent to BSNL to provide I GB link to CUO campus at Sunabeda.

The National Mission of Education through Information Communication Technology (NME-ICT) programme is supported by MHRD. The I GB connectivity is provided for 10 years for 400 Nodes. The LAN set up is also provided under the scheme limiting to 7.5 KM. 25% of the expenditure is borne by the University. The estimated cost of the scheme is Rs. 2.00 crore. As regards cost sharing ratio is as follows.

- 3. Procurement of switches and accessories.

- 5. Procurement and installation of systems (Computer) in different buildings.
- 6. Commissioning of 05 and 06 of above to avoid any damage.

The BSNL has been requested to submit an estimate.

FINANCE

Central University of Orissa, Koraput has been established by an Act of Parliament, under the Central Universities Act, 2009. Being a Central University, it is being funded by MHRD through UGC. Central University of Orissa, Koraput has started functioning since 29/08/2009. The University has been receiving fund from the Central Government in the form of Plan Block Grant as General Development Assistance (GDA), provision for Community College Scheme and B.Voc.programmes. The Fund is utilised broadly under three heads: Grant-in-Aid (Recurring expenses), Grant-in-Aid (Salary) and Grant-in-Aid (Creation of Capital Assets).

The General Development Assistance (GDA) covers construction/renovation of building (including renovation of heritage buildings), campus development, staff, books & journals, laboratory, equipment and infrastructure, annual maintenance contract, innovative research activities, university industry linkages, extension activities, cultural activities, development of ICT, health care, student amenities including hostels, Non-NET Fellowships to students, Travel Grant, Conferences/Seminars/Symposia/Workshops, Publication Grant, Appointment of Visiting Professor/Visiting Fellow and Establishment of Career & Counselling Cell, Day Care Centres, basic facilities for women and Faculty Development Programme, etc.

Besides Plan Grant, the University does also receive funds from Central & State Government bodies like Odisha Bio-Diversity of Board, Nalco Foundation, National Remote Sensing Centre, Hyderabad and Foreign Institutions (viz University of Santiago de Compostela, Spain) for undertaking various Research Projects.

The Accounts of the University are audited annually by the Principal Director of Audit (Central), Hyderabad through their Branch Office at Bhubaneswar, Odisha on behalf of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India. As provided under the Act, the Audited Annual Accounts for the year 2013-14 together with Separate Audit Report (SAR) and replies of the University thereto were placed on the tables of both the Houses of the Indian Parliament on 23.12.2014 through Ministry of Human Recourses Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

The Annual Accounts of the University for the Financial Year, 2014-15 have been prepared as per the prescribed time schedule on 'accrual basis' in accordance with the revised formats issued by MHRD following the prescribed "Accounting Standards". The Annual Accounts (2014-15) have been approved by the Finance Committee and Executive Council of the University in their meeting held on 30.06.2014 (F.N.) and 30.06.2014 (A.N.), respectively.

The approved Annual Accounts (2014-15) have been audited by the Dy. Director of Audit (Central), Bhubaneswar Odisha, for certification. The Statutory Audit has issued a Draft Separate Audit Report (SAR) on the Annual Accounts. The University has issued the replies to the Draft SAR.

On receipt of the Final Separate Audit Report (SAR), the Audited Annual Accounts together with the Final SAR and the replies of the University thereto will be placed before the Finance Committee and the Executive Council of the University for their Consideration and approval in their next meeting or by Circulation. On approval, the same will be sent to MHRD for placing them on the tables of both the Houses of the Parliament.

DEVELOPMENT OF OUR NEW CAMPUS

BRIEF NOTE ON LAND MATTER

For establishing Central University of Orissa at Sunabeda, Govt. of Odisha have sanctioned advance possession of land measuring 430.37 acres vide letter No.34818 dated 3.9.2009 at free of cost in village Chikapar and Chakarliput under Semiliguda.

Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Govt. of Odisha have sanctioned the lease proposal and communicated vide their



Guest House at the permanent Campus of CUO, Sunabeda.

letter No. 27669 dated.18.09.2014 fixing the ground rent, cess, interest and incidental charges as on date of sanction amounting to Rs.3,88,78,593/- towards recurring and non-recurring dues. Further action regarding payment of Govt. dues, signing of agreement between Govt. of Odisha and Central University of Orissa and transfer of land is being followed.

INFRASTRUCTURAL PROGRESS

In order to improve the level of infrastructure and other ancillary facilities and meet the requirements of structural development at the Main Campus, the University has been able to create the required infrastructure to make the Campus functional from the Academic Year 2013-14. Some of the noteable infrastructural developments made during the year are stated below:

- In the first phase, the construction of the Boundary Wall of 9.3 km length spreading over 430.37 acres of land allotted by the State Government at Sunabeda, Koraput was completed.
- The construction of the CUO Guest House (G+3) of 2,957 sq. mtr. (plinth area) having 32 rooms and 08 suites at the Main Campus keeping in accordance with the characteristic of Odisha architecture has been completed and inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Union Minister of HRD on the 1st July 2013.
 - The construction of the Boys' Hostel (G+3) of 7,735 sq. mtr. (Plinth area) having 236 rooms has been completed and also inaugurated by the then Hon'ble Union Minister of HRD on the 1st July 2013.
- Similarly, the construction of the Girls' Hostel (G+3) of 7,735 sq. mtr. (plinth area) having 236 rooms has also been completed.
- The construction of Academic Block of 1,700 sq. mtr plinth areas has also been completed and both the Blocks have already been inaugurated on the 21st January, 2013.
- The construction of the Library Wing of 775 sq. mtr (Plinth area) at the Main Campus has been completed
 and functioned from last academic year.



- A Conference-cum-Seminar Hall has also been developed in the Academic Block at the Main Campus. The Conference Hall is well equipped and fixed with conference furniture supplied by Godrej.
- For providing beverage facility to the students and staff, construction of a Canteen at the Main Campus has been completed.

- The approval of Master Plan and Building Design are in process. The selection of Architectural Firm is
 in progress. An Action Plan for an Eco-friendly and Energy Saving Green Campus as per GRIHA has
 been drafted. The University is committed to recycling of waste, utilizing of renewable energy, water
 harvesting and environment impact assessment.
- Laboratories for the Department for Anthropological Studies, Department for Journalism & Mass Communication and Department of Biodiversity & Conservation of Natural Resources have been established in the Landiguda Campus.
- The New Campus at Sunabeda got regular electricity supply recently.

EXPANSION OF THE MAIN CAMPUS

Classes at Main campus of Central University of Orissa at Sunabeda started on 20th October, 2013 with shifting of the Department for Teacher Education (B.Ed. Programme) there. As first batch of 100 students took admission in B.Ed. Programme, it was decided to start the Course from the Main campus. The B.Ed. classes are running with 06 members of the Faculty and 100 students. Subsequently, the Centre of Sociological Studies

(CSS) shifted to the main campus and classes started from 20th December, 2013. Three members of the faculty with 80 P.G. students, 01 Ph.D. and 04 M.Phil. scholars have been continuing the academic programmes since then.

On 7th July, 2014 another two Departments i.e. Department for Mathematics & Department for Economics were shifted to the main campus. The classes of Mathematics are running with two faculty members and 84 students. Similarly the classes of Economics are running with three faculty members and 61 students. Presently total students' strength at the main campus is 350.
