## Five-Day Research Methodology Workshop for language scholars Begins at CUO

A five-day workshop on *Research Methodology* commenced at the Central University of Odisha (CUO) on Monday, 07 April 2025, aiming to equip participants with essential knowledge and skills for conducting rigorous and meaningful research in the field of language studies. The workshop, which covers both qualitative and quantitative research approaches, is being organized by the School of Languages of CUO.

The workshop was inaugurated by Prof. N. C. Panda, Vice-Chancellor (In-Charge) and Dean, School of Languages, in the presence of resource person Prof. Arun Ranjan Mishra, retired Professor, Department of Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrit, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan, West Bengal.
