Workshop Objectives

Diverse Open Access Models: Introduce participants to various open access models—Gold, Green, and Hybrid—highlighting the benefits and challenges of each. **Open Public Licensing:** Discuss the importance of open public licensing, with a focus on Creative Commons licenses, ensuring participants understand how to protect their work while promoting accessibility. **Resources for Ethical Publishing:** Guide participants through the use of critical resources like the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), emphasizing ethical standards and best practices in open access publishing.

3. Effective Utilization of Open Publishing Platforms:

Open Journal System (OJS): Provide hands-on training in using OJS (Open Journal System), covering the entire workflow from installation and journal setup to submission management, peer review, and content publication. **Practical Exercises:** Engage participants in practical exercises to reinforce their understanding of OJS, ensuring they can confidently manage an open access journal.

4. Integration of ORCID for Enhanced Researcher Visibility:

Understanding ORCID: Offers a comprehensive overview of ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID), explaining its significance in the academic ecosystem for maintaining accurate and consistent researcher profiles. **ORCID API Integration with OJS:** Demonstrates the integration of the ORCID API with OJS, enabling participants to streamline author identification and improve the accuracy of research attribution.

5. Promoting Global Collaboration and Innovation:

Networking and Collaboration Opportunities: Foster an environment that encourages networking and collaboration among participants.
