CUO@16: The Vision for a Viksit Koraput

The Central University of Odisha is coming of age. Based on its glorious past, the University is on its way to become a premier higher educational institution in India. Presently the CUO is resonating with the voices of a mini Bharat-Teachers from all parts of the country including Odisha, Bihar, West Bengal, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu have joined the University to take it to a new height by shaping a National Character through Unity amidst diversity. We currently have a strength of 65 regular teachers in levels of Professor, Associate Professor, and Assistant Professor. And many more to come....

Education is not simply a class lecture, notes, and examination thing; it is much more. It is a process of nation-building through human character-building. Education inspires a student to think about contributing to the betterment of society. Therefore, it should always be linked to society. The CUO is committed to nation-building through its academic programmes and innovative teaching pedagogy. The new UG courses which have been started are aimed to establish a social connect with the academia-Agriculture, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Forest Management, Supply & Retail Chain Management-all these programmes are going to come up not only with skilled human resource but also open up a new vista of Atmanirbhar Bharat by production and marketing of FMCG products right from the laps of the nature mother of Koraput to the international market. Why should not we dream that the Animal Husbandry & Dairying Department will produce 100 % pure milk and the Department of Supply & Retail Chain Management will package & market them with a branding of CUO, Koraput? Koraput's very own country banana (*Desi Kadali*) is unique as it is rich in nutrients and does not decompose

but only dries over time. With these programmes should we not dream of marketing Koraputia *Desi Kadali* at the international forums? I am extremely optimistic. Steps are already being taken to start organic farming.

Talking about international collaborations, the CUO has forged a partnership with the Japan Foundation and running a Certificate Course in Japanese Language with resounding success. We are on the way to many such international partnerships and collaborations with foreign higher educational institutions. The head and eyes are surveying the world but our feet is firmly rooted in the ground of our very own Bharat, precisely in Koraput. We believe that Language is a vital vehicle of communication and empowers a person to climb the ladders of success. Through a partnership with the Central Hindi Institute (Kendriya Hindi Sansthan) the CUO has embarked upon a Mahayagna, titled as the Hindi Literacy Mission (Hindi Swaksharata Abhiyaan) where a group of dedicated, patriotic teachers of CUO led by the School of Languages are going around in different villages of Koraput and various colleges & universities of Odisha to enhance the skills of Hindi, the official language of India which will empower people at margins to participate more effectively in the affairs of the mainstream of society. Collaborative initiatives are also on at the National Level with reputed institutions like the Indira Gandhi Centre for Arts. New Delhi who visited Koraput in April 2024 for a study tour with a 60 member team comprising students & faculty. Both CHI & IGNCA are considering to start regional centres at CUO campus at Koraput. That will be an exciting academic proposition as Koraput will have explicit representation and base at the national capital. Partnership with Hindustan Aeronautics Limited is also an important milestone. The CUO is shortly coming up with a book in collaboration with G M University, Sambalpur.

The CUO is committed to the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020. The nation is in the process of adopting NEP and CUO is also on the job. The essence of NEP lies in the fact that it offers the independence to learners to study and write examination in their own language and removes the burden of English, which remains a bone of contention for students of remote and backward areas. The CUO has recently launched Primers in Kui & Desia Language, both spoken by the people of the undivided Koraput region in association with the NCERT, New Delhi. Going with the ethos of NEP which advocates the use of outcome based, skill based education the CUO through the Dep't of Journalism & Mass Communication, organized a 15 day Film Making Workshop for ST students in association with the Film & Television Institute of India, Pune (Ministry of Information & Broadcasting, Government of India) in February 2024 under the Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. In the same spirit, the CUO is also producing a research based documentary film on Bonda Tribe under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat. The Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi has expressed its desire to hold a programme on Desia Literature at the CUO campus. The CUO has become a favourite destination of the National Level Government Institutions in recent times! In order to meet its mandate of tribal development through education, the CUO is regularly conducting Coaching for Competitive Examinations for SC/ST students through DACE. In an effort to make students aware about their own roots, the CUO has organized the Paramparik Kreeda

*Mahotsav* where tribal athletes from all over the country participated in a rare Olympic of our own sporting events like Manipur's *Thang ta* and Medinipur's *Raybenshe*.

# The effort was hailed as "laudatory initiative" by none other than Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in his X-handle. We are grateful, Sir.

The introduction of Gopabandhu Studies in UG is an effort to expose current batch of students to the great ideals of the makers of modern Bharat. Life & work of great sons of Odia soil, Utkal Gourab Madhusudan Das is being translated to Hindi and English.

The Faculty members of the CUO have been regularly travelling to attend seminars, conferences and workshops and making a mark for themselves. In recent times our Faculty members have visited countries like South Korea and Sri Lanka. Faculty delegations have made an emphatic mark in national level workshops at NIEPA, New Delhi, VC Conference of Eastern India Universities for NEP implementation at Gauhati and was awarded First Prize in the Government Achievements & Schemes Expo-2024 organized by NNS Media Group in Delhi in July 2024.

Infrastructure wise, the prospect looks promising. The new Academic Block (G+3) is on the verge of completion and very soon we will be functioning from there. The foundation stone for the Administrative Block also has been laid. The staff quarters are also going on in full swing. It is a matter of great honour that CUO was granted a sum of Rs 129 Crores and Rs. 479 Crores for infrastructure development whose blue print is also being made. The CUO has also been granted the Bhima Bhoi Chair.

The CUO believes that a student is an asset of the nation and in a responsible student lies the future of the nation. The admission process for the new two departments of Botany and Zoology have already started and it is expected that along with the Research Centre for Bio Diversity (in conceptual stage) the research in science will achieve a new height.

On the occasion of the XVI Foundation Day, I recall the contribution of my revered predecessor Vice Chancellors, Prof Surabhi Banerjee, Prof Sachidananda Mohanty and late Prof I Ramabrahmam and all those workers who have been here in CUO since its inception. # Institutions, Governance and Excellence The role of Youth in/for BHARAT -2047.

#### **Institutions:**

Zucker and Scott defined institutions as, "Cognitive, normative and the regulatory structures and activities that provide stability and meaning to social behaviour..... Are transported by various carriers-culture, structures and the routines-and they operated multiple levels of jurisdiction."

Every initiation has a purpose, time for maturity, stabilisation, hope and trust generation. The Indian examples include many ancient educational institutions at Nalanda et cetera. Great Scriptures were written and handed over from generation to generation through a continuous process. There is a continuity of this tradition in the time the invasions derailed the continuity.

Every institution starts as an organization with the purpose of long-term survival. There is an expectation of all stakeholders for the survival and pursuit of excellence at this time of origin of the institution. It is the purpose of the initiation to fulfil the legitimate expectation of the stakeholder.

#### INSTITUTION VERSUS ORGANIZATION:

Darwin's theory emphasises on survival. The best organization survive who are fast in response to challenging external threats. The solution lies in change management which involves the following.

- 1. Innovation
- 2. Diversification of products/services.
- 3. Constant learning.

- 4. ENHANCEMENT mentality.
- 5. Maximising profits.
- 6. Minimising interference.
- 7. Acquiring Legitimacy through approval by the environment, approval by globalizing ecosystem, social awareness, and sustainability.
- 8. Readiness towards modernization.
- 9. Michael Porter's theory of cost, leadership and differentiation.
- 10. Corporate Social Responsibility.
- 11. Stakeholder concept.
- 12. TOTAL QUALITY MANAGEMENT concept.
- 13. KAIZEN and 6 sigma.

- 16. Balanced spirit.
- "Institution is an organization that reaches legitimacy with the defined features such as
- 1. Serving the needs of stakeholders. According to Freeman, a stakeholder is" any group or individual who is affected by or who can effect the objectives of achievement of an organization." There are eleven categories of stakeholders which are as follows.
- 1. Owners. 2. Consumer advocates. 3. Customers. 4. Competitors. 5. Media. 6. Employees. 7. Group of followers. 8. Ecologists. 9. Suppliers. 10. Governments. And 11. Local community organizations.
- 2. Performance of responsible management:
  - 1953 was the year when the concept of CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY was introduced. CSR is a part of rational choice theory. It means maximising utility and minimising the risk at the same time and thus contributing to economic efficiency, social efficacy, and political effectiveness.
- 3. Promotion of human dignity and social justice: John Rawls introduced the concept of social pact. Corporate justice and social justice go together. Promotion of human Abilities and essential freedoms is important.
- 4. Performance of job, recognised by stakeholders:

Corporate/INSTITUTIONAL REPUTATION will spring through public recognition and social justification of distinctive features of the role of the institution in is society. The distinctive elements of the features are Ecology, Environmental protection, Accounting, Ethics, Communication, Responsive Administration, Strategy, and Marketing. The most severely affected vital groups are Customers, Employees, Shareholders, and the general members of society.

#### 5. ROLES and RULES:

"Institutions Are rules of the game and organisations are players". This was the opening of scholar North (1990). The definition given by Max Weber is not out of place. Organization is the operation of formal rules." When formal rules are found inadequate, routines are developed" (j.Valencia,2003).

#### 6. ETHICS:

The oil Crisis in the Year 1973 and the Vietnam War followed by the Cold War replaced the state with nonstate actors as the establishment of the equilibrium among global trade functions. Ethics and efficiency go together in the long run. Examples are the organisations like the CUMMINS AND TATAS. Empirical studies prove that ethical organization/institution will solve social problems also.

### 7. Respect for Rules/regulations/law:

Richard Posner mentioned that the coercive instrument of the government exercises the balance in the market. Stigler questioned the capacity of the state to correct the market imbalance.

#### 8. CHANGE MANAGEMENT:

According to scholar North (1990), "institutions are the formal and informal rules that offer both opportunities and constraints for organisational actions." Institutions undergo isomorphic and non-isomorphic changes. Isomorphic changes are common and inherent. Non-isomorphic changes contribute either to the growth or to the decay of the institution.

#### 9. ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT.

#### 10. POSITIVE ROLE for EMPLOYEES.

#### **GOVERNANCE:**

GOVERNANCE ENCOMPASSES the system in which an organization is controlled and operates and the mechanism by which it and its people or held to account. Ethics, risk management, compliance and administration are the three elements of governance.

Excellence is the quality of being a truly the best at a chosen something. The eightfold path for excellence is as follows.

- 1. Value addition to customers.
- 2. Sustainable future.



He has identified one high protein and low glycemic index rice, "Kalajeera," a popular variety for better consumption by diabetic patients.




#### Dr. Vikash Kumar M.Sc., Ph.D. Assistant Professor




# Dr. Chandrasekhar B M.Tech., Ph.D. Assistant Professor (Animal Husbandry & Dairying)


